Vintage Notes

Winter was hard and very dry with low temperatures that continued right until the middle of May. After a summer of dramatic contrasts and some hydric stress, there was welcome rainfall in September. The harvest was characterised by irregular maturation, reduced yields and a scrupulous selection of grapes.

Tasting Note

Fragrant and serious on the nose, with notes of red fruit and jam plus a very discrete oak that does not mask the fruit. On the palate it is dense, soft and mouth-filling, with firm tannins, good depth accompanied by bright, clear and splendidly defined fruit.

Ageing Details and Overall Assessment

This 2002 was bottled in June 2004, after 15 months ageing in French and American oak barrels of varying ages. Very attractive and approachable in its youth, this year is notable for its delicacy and sensuality.
