

TERREUS “PAGO DE CUEVABAJA” 2001

Alcoholic degree: 14.5°

Grape Varieties: Tempranillo 95%- Garnacha: 5%

Type of soil: sandy and clay, deep and light.

Yields: 3.500 kg por ha

Ageing: 30 in new french barrels.

Bottling date:: On august 2004

Production: 7.000 bottles, 125 magnums, 15 x3 litres, 5 x6 litres.

2001:

Mild and wet climata up to budburst with specific frosts during spring which reduce the crop. A dry and warm summer and a mild september permits to begin harvest in Cueva Baja at the end of september with low yields and a shorter production than previous vintages.

Terreus 2001 Intense and racy wine, fleshy and opulent with huge and focused tannins and a big purity of fruit.
