Vintage:

A very dry year with an early harvest, and much lower yields than in previous vintages. The best quality came from mature vines whose deep root structure ensured slower ripening. These gave a very good expression of the typicity of our 'terroir'.

Tasting notes:

This year's Mauro radiates freshness, charm and sensuality. On the nose the fruit is more upfront than ever and on the palate there are no angles, with a creamy texture, polished tannins and magnificent harmony.

Ageing:

It was bottled in June 2007 after 16 months ageing in French and American oak barrels of varying ages.
