Alcoholic degree: 14.5 %

Grape Varieties: Tempranillo 90 %, Syrah: 10%

Vineyards: Tudela de Duero- Santibáñez de Valcorba

Vintage

Abundant rainfall in winter and spring with no significant frost. A very fresh summer delayed the start of veraison, but high temperatures between 23rd of August and 7th of September brought the harvest forward with the aim of maintaining a balanced acidity and to avoid over ripening.

Tasting notes

Filled with aromas, clear notes of red fruit (raspberries, strawberries) and marked floral tones. Fine, rounded and rich with flexible tannins and pronounced freshness on the finish.

Ageing:

Bottled in June 2008 after ageing for 16 months in French and American oak barrels of varying ages.
