

TERREUS “PAGO DE CUEVA BAJA” 2003

Alcoholic degree: 15 °

Grape Varieties: Tempranillo 100%

Type of soil: sandy and clay, fine textured and deep.

Yields: 3.500 kg per ha

Ageing: 32 months in French oak

Bottling date: November 2006

2003:

The growing season was characterised by mild, frost free, but wet winter and an early budburst. Veraison was rapid in the long hot summer, and the harvest began on 19th of September in warm conditions ensuring perfectly healthy grapes.

Impressive and subtle nose of raspberries, grilled toast and liquorice. Massive, opulent and mouthfilling with abundant but supple tannins. A voluptuous Terreus of fascinating aromas and full palate.
